



HARVEST TIME!

"And let us not lose heart and grow weary and faint in acting nobly and doing right, for in due time and at the appointed season we shall reap, if we do not loosen and relax our courage and faint." (Galatians 6:9 - AMP)

1. Today I will live in the now! 5. Today I will be sustained by the living vision within me that produces a second wind, allowing Him to be strong in my weakness. I will not give up. I will never give up. I will in no way give up. I will by no means give up. I will find it impossible to give up. I will be incapable of giving up. I will simply refuse to give up. I will renounce any thought of giving up. I will not listen to those who tell me to give up. I will know that I can't give up. I will admit that I don't know how to give up. I just won't give up. Not now. Not ever.
6. Today I will run and not be weary. I will walk and not faint.
7. Today I will open my spiritual eyes and see the harvest around me . . . no complaining . . . no worrying . . . no intimidation — just believing and receiving today. Today I will know that the field is the world, and the world is the field, and today I will live in the now!
